#### A Safe Professional Online Community for Educators

TeachOntario is a safe professional space for Ontario's educators. One of the features that makes it safe is that registered users are required to use their EDU, school district (TDSB, YCDSB, etc.), or faculty of education (WU, UofT, etc.) email address to register.

Here are examples of accepted email addresses.



Here's how to create a TeachOntario account.


Remember: You'll need your school district email address.

Here's how to create your account:

- Please go to TeachOntario on your desktop/laptop browser. Here's the link: https://www.teachontario.ca/welcome
- Click onto Register (Look to the top right)



- You'll need to use your school district email address (e.g., your.name@wrdsb.on.ca, your.name@ugdsb.on.ca)
- When you've completed filling in the fields, click on "Create Account"



Check your school district email address for a validation email.

#### **Access Working Sandbox Groups in Share/Create**

The SHARE/CREATE sections are only accessible to those registered and logged in to TeachOntario.

TeachOntario members can access the great groups, discussions and blog posts in SHARE and CREATE only when they have an account and are logged in. The public cannot see these groups, discussions, blog posts and other resources.

### What are the benefits of using TeachOntario and its Sandbox Capabilities in Share/Create?

Creating a working sandbox is a way for a community of practice to start sharing ideas collaboratively -- in the safety of a space meant only for the group. The group can set their own group access. Here are the levels within TeachOntario: Open, Members Only, Private and Secret.

## How do CoP leaders or course facilitators get started with their Sandbox Group?

You'll be able to create and upload video, images, polls, documents, discussions and blog posts. Some groups have used their Sandbox groups to store meeting minutes, share videos and start discussions.

# How do CoP leaders or course facilitators invite others in their community or group to their Sandbox Group on TeachOntario?

As mentioned, all users need to register is a valid email address from EDU, a Faculty of Education or School District or School Authority.

Please ask your colleagues or the members of your CoP to register onto TeachOntario. If they need support, our Community Manager Albert can help them.

From there, we can help ensure your colleagues become members of your group. All that is needed is an invitation to your colleague and for CoP leaders or course facilitators to accept them into the group.
